<p>The current residential solid waste services fee is \$15.07, and is listed on the month City Utility Services bill, along with water and sewer service. In addition to weekly collection of refuse and recycling containers, the fee also covers other solid waste services and programs.</p> <p>Refuse and recycling containers are each collected once a week. Refuse containers on alleys serve approximately three to four homes. Per City Code, curbside containers must be placed at the curb for collection prior to 6 a.m. on the day of collection, or the evening before if it is more convenient. Residents are reminded to remove containers from the curb by the end of the collection day. Residents with alley collection service are responsible for keeping alleys free of weeds and debris from their fence line to the center of the alley.</p> <p>For excess amounts of refuse or recyclables, residents may call (480) 782-3510 to schedule a free curbside bulk collection twice a year, and thereafter, \$25 per scheduled bulk collection.
